

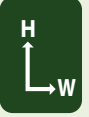
# Lomandra KATIE BELLES™

Lomandra longifolia 'LHBYF' PPAF



## Leaf:

- Grassy foliage; pine-green in sunny locations and deep green when planted in shade.
- Broad, strappy foliage



## Habit:

- 4 ft H x 4 ft W; Zone 8-11 & Evergreen in 8b
- Tufting grass with an arched to weeping habit
- Matures slowly; not uncommon for this plant to take 2 years to "settle in" after planting.



## Apps:

- Streetscapes & Commercial Landscapes
- Mass, Group or Specimen Plantings
- Home Gardens
- Retention Ponds, Bioswales, Water Features



## Bloom:

- Large yellow-orange flower spikes that sit slightly above foliage in late spring; very fragrant. Blooming is light until plants are established; usually in the second full season.

## Notables:

- LIKES - Moist soils; Filtered sun to moderate shade
- DISLIKES - Full sun and temps below 20 degrees F
- Moisture tolerant, large, fragrant flower spikes

A selection of Creek Mat Rush with big, fragrant orange-yellow flower spikes in late spring. As the name suggests, this Lomandra is not only drought tolerant like thier L. longifolia cousins but it also has the added benefit of being able to tolerate periods of wet feet. Like other Lomandra, Katie Belles will tolerate full sun but prefers filtered sun to moderate shade. Great as an accent plant or in mass.
