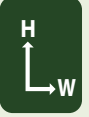


Dianella LITTLE BECCA™

Dianella caerulea 'DCMP01' PP18,452



- Leaf:**
- Bright to dark green, soft foliage
 - Medium-textured, strappy leaves



- Habit:**
- 2 ft H x 1.5 ft W
 - Clumping to spreading perennial with a mounding habit at maturity.
 - Zone 8-11; Evergreen to Zone 9.



- Apps:**
- Commercial & Streetscaping
 - Group, Border or Specimen Plantings
 - Water-wise home Gardens
 - EROSION CONTROL!



- Bloom:**
- Clusters of small purple flowers borne on branched peduncles that sit just above the foliage.

- Notables:**
- **LIKES** - Moist conditions; Free-draining soil; Full sun
 - **DISLIKES** - Shade; excessive cold weather.
 - Drought tolerant, heat tolerant, great for mass plantings



TUFFY

High Impact
Low Maintenance



Glossy dark green foliage that slowly spreads by creeping rootstock gives this Dianella a mounding habit. Perfect for mass plantings, Little Becca has been used in many commercial sites and highway projects. This variety seems to do well with or without [much] irrigation and will remain evergreen to temps down to the mid to low twenties. Best when planted in full sun with moderate irrigation.
