Lomandra longifolia 'LHCOM' PP20,759



## Leaf:

- Grassy foliage; pine-green in sunny locations and deep green when planted in shade.
- Broad, strappy foliage



## Habit:

- 4 ft H x 4 ft W; Zone 8-11, evergreen 8b
- Tufting grass with an arched to weeping habit
- Matures slowly; not uncommon for this plant to take 2 years to "settle in" after planting.

- Very Large Planters
- Mass, Group or Specimen Plantings

## Bloom:

- Yellow-orange, highly branched flower spikes that sit slightly above foliage in late spring; lightly fragrant. Blooming is light until plants are established; usually in the second full season.

## Notables:

- LIKES - Moist soils; Filtered sun to moderate shade
- DISLIKES - Full sun and temps below 20 degrees F
- Moisture tolerant, frost tolerant, attractive flower spikes

A compact selection of Creek Mat Rush and, as the name suggests, this Lomandra is not only drought tolerant like their L. longifolia cousins but it also has the added benefit of being able to tolerate periods of wet feet. Like other Lomandra, TropicBelle will tolerate full sun but prefers filtered sun to moderate shade. TropicBelle also has good salt tolerance making it a good choice for coastal plantings.
